

RAAE INSTRUCTIONS FOR REVIEWERS

Annotating Anonymously

The RAAE is a scholarly open access, **double blind peer-reviewed** international journal. Please make sure that your comments are free of person data.

ADOBE ACROBAT:

Before you begin adding your reviewer comments or editing the text:

1. Under **"Edit"** in the upper toolbar, select **"Preferences."**
 - a. Under **"Categories"** (the left column of choices), select **"Commenting."**
 - i. Under **"Making Comments,"** uncheck the box **"Always use Log-in Name for Author."**
 - ii. Click **"OK."**
2. Insert your first comment [use **"Note Tool," "Text Edits,"** or **"Add Sticky Note"**].
 - a. **Right-click** (Windows) or Control-click (Mac OS) the comment or edited text box and select **"Properties."**
 - i. Under **"General,"** **remove** the name that appears under "Author." Leave this field blank or insert **"Reviewer."**
 - ii. Click **"Close"** or **"Okay."**
 - b. To make this setting a default so that your identity will continue to be hidden in all subsequent comments and text edits, right-click (Windows) or control-click (Mac OS) the same comment or edited text box and select **"Make Current Properties Default."**
